FORMATO

Tiempo total del examen: 10 minutos.

El examen tiene dos partes:

- 1.-Presentación de un **topic (tema)** preparado por el alumno seguida de una discusión sobre ese tema con el examinador (5 minutos).
- 2.-Una **conversación** general con el examinador (5 minutos).

TOPIC

Puede ser cualquier tema en el que el alumno esté interesado, del que tenga algún conocimiento y sea capaz de hablar con soltura. El propósito del tema es que el alumno tenga la oportunidad de mostrar el inglés que sabe que puede usar. Sin embargo, se debe evitar elegir un tema que coincida con la lista de temas de conversación en la segunda parte del examen. Se recomienda que traigan al examen dibujos, fotos, diagramas, modelos o cualquier otro objeto para ilustrar el tema y estimular la conversación con el examinador. Sin materiales adecuados puede que el alumno no de todo lo mejor de él y reciba notas más bajas. Sin embargo no se pueden llevar animales vivos al examen.

El topic se divide en 6 puntos principales y se tiene que preparar material suficiente para una presentación de un topic de unos 2 o 3 minutos, no más. Y no se debe repetir el tema de memoria sin comprender lo que se está diciendo, ya que el examinador puede empezar con cualquiera de los 6 puntos de los que consta el "Topic form".

Al preparar el topic se recomienda que el alumno introduzca vocabulario importante y se anticipe a las preguntas que le puedan hacer. Debe estar preparado para dar ejemplos, explicaciones y aclaraciones si así se lo pide el examinador. **Hacer al menos 1 pregunta al examinador.**

CONVERSACIÓN

La conversación puede ser sobre dos de alguno de estos temas: viajes, dinero, moda, reglas y reglamentos, salud y ponerse en forma, aprender un idioma extranjero. El objetivo de la conversación es establecer un intercambio tan interesante y relajado como permitan los intereses y habilidad del alumno. **Hacer al menos 2 preguntas al examinador.**

GRAMATICA

- 1st Condicional, usando *if* y *when*.
- pasado continuo.
- Presente continuo para expresar futuro.
- Modales apropiados para expresar y pedir opinión, impresión, obligación, necesidad, propósito, intenciones, seguridad e inseguridad...
- Uso del infinitivo de propósito.
- Conectores de frases : *and, but, because, etc.*

PREGUNTAS & RESPUESTAS FRECUENTES

I was talking to my friend on the telephone.

- What was your family doing while you were shopping for clothes?

They were waiting for me in a cafeteria.

- What do you think of boys' fashions today?

I don't think there's a lot of choice for boys. What do you think?

- Do you have to help your mother in the house?

No but if I don't, she doesn't give me any pocket money.

- And what do you spend it on?

I use it to buy clothes and magazines.

- Have prices gone up a lot recently?

Yes, since the introduction of the Euro a lot of shopkeepers have put up their prices.

- So if Britain joins the Euro, what do you think will happen?

We have to wait and see but probably prices will rise. Is that what you think?

- Tell me what you thought of the play.

I didn't like it at all. I thought the characters were not real.

- What are you doing this evening?

I'll probably go to the cinema with my friend.

- What are some of the differences between London and Barcelona?

London is bigger than Barcelona. The best thing about London is Big Ben

- Tell me about your hobbies.

- What is your topic?

I want to talk about festivals in my country.

- Are there any other festivals?

- Please ask me a question.
