Paper 2 Writing
Refer to Cambridge ESOL Marking Scheme in the Teachers' Handbooks, or ask Angeles for full details.
Four areas of language are measured $(\mathrm{Ca}, \mathrm{L}, \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{O})$, a score of 0 to 5 is given to each area creating a maximum of 20 for each piece of writing ( 4 areas x 5 points max $=$ max 20). A percentage for each writing can be calculated from the scores by multiplying each point by 5 ; for example $10 / 20=50 \%(10 \times 5=50) 14 / 20=70 \%$
