In what the organisers call the Barbie **Dreamhouse** Experience, a hundred gallons of pink paint were used to **decorate** the exhibition. The colour **provoked** a protest from a group called Pink **Stinks** whose members said there was too much **emphasis** on becoming more beautiful and on being pretty, and that put an **awful** lot of pressure on girls. The other Barbie Dreamhouse, in America, has not been the target of **protest**. The Berlin version continues until August and then **tours** Europe. There will be more opportunity for protest - and also for visits by Barbie's **countless** fans
