Part 1 =	2 points for each correct answer (16 points)

Paper 2 Writing

Refer to Cambridge ESOL Marking Scheme in the Teachers' Handbooks, or ask Angeles for full details.

Four areas of language are measured (**Ca, L, C, O**), a score of 0 to 5 is given to each area creating a maximum of 20 for each piece of writing (4 areas x 5 points max = max 20). A percentage for each writing can be calculated from the scores by multiplying each point by 5; for example $10/20 = 50\%$ ($10 \times 5 = 50$) $14/20 = 70\%$

CA (Communicative achievement) 3

L (Language) 3

C (Content) 4

O (Organisation) 4
